

COVID-19 VACCINE CLINICS for patients aged 6 months – 4 years

- 1) Our office has chosen to administer the Moderna vaccine to all eligible children aged 6 months – 4 years. It is a 2-dose primary series with doses being given at least 4 weeks apart. Please schedule both doses at the time of the call.
- 2) **We ask families that have an upcoming appointment scheduled on or before July 7th to receive their vaccine at the time of that appointment for their convenience (can be a well, sick or nurse visit), and to accommodate as many patients as quickly as we can. If the family doesn't have an existing appointment, then the patient can be added to any of the available covid vaccine clinics Wednesday and Thursday afternoons, Thursday evenings, or Saturday mornings. Families that receive Dose 1 at an existing office visit can schedule Dose 2 at the time of the visit.**
 - **The exception is the 12-month visit, as the child will already be receiving 4 vaccines at the time of the visit.**
- 3) If your child is 4 years old and will turn 5, they will still receive Moderna vaccine for both doses.
- 4) If your child has turned 5 already, they will receive the Pfizer vaccine authorized for 5-11years.
- 5) Per CDC guidelines, children can receive their COVID-19 vaccine at the time of other immunizations.
- 6) Families must plan on waiting in the clinic for 15 minutes after receiving the vaccine. Masks are mandatory for individuals 2 years and older.
- 7) Any patient with a history of allergies should bring their Epi-pen.
- 8) Please only 1 parent/guardian in the clinic at a time, multiple children are allowed 2 parents if necessary.
